Position Summary:

The Youth Suicide Worker will support youth and their families by creating access to cultural activities, wellness workshops, and wraparound supports. The role focuses on cultural reconnection, community building, and advocacy, while also ensuring youth are linked to the appropriate services, education, and resources to support their journey.

Key Responsibilities:

- Plan, organize, and facilitate cultural and land-based activities, workshops.
- Build trusting, supportive relationships with youth, families, and caregivers using a trauma-informed and culturally safe approach.
- Support youth who are in care, transitioning out of care, or navigating homelessness by providing individualized advocacy and referrals.
- Collaborate with community partners to support spiritual, cultural, and emotional needs.
- Provide appropriate referrals to youth experiencing mental health and/or addiction challenges.
- Promote education and awareness around mental health, harm reduction, identity, and cultural revitalization.
- Maintain confidential client records, reports, and statistics in accordance with organizational and funding requirements.
- Participate in team meetings, training, and community events as required.

Qualifications:

- Strong understanding of Indigenous histories, cultures, values, and traditions—preferably grounded in lived experience.
- Experience working with Indigenous youth and families, particularly those impacted by the child welfare system, homelessness, or addictions.
- Knowledge of trauma-informed, harm reduction, and strength-based approaches.
- Experience in community outreach, case management, or program coordination is an asset.
- Knowledge of local resources and networks that serve Indigenous communities.

- Must pass a Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector Screening provided within three months of hire.
- Valid driver's license and access to reliable transportation are assets.
